ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE BUILDING ON THURSDAY, NO EXCEPTIONS.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 6:00 am on Friday or when grooming set up is complete.

On Saturday & Sunday the Show Site will be available at 6:00 am. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday. The building will be locked at 11:00 pm Friday & Saturday nights.

Dogs may be left in the building overnight, but you **MUST** have your dogs name, your name and phone number on every crate that has a dog in it. A club member will be in the electrical parking with a key to the building in case of an emergency.

There is no crating, grooming, or tabling allowed ringside or in the aisles. Trolleys on wheels will be allowed ringside only during that breed's judging assignment and will be removed immediately. Grooming is allowed in designated grooming areas only (free and reserved grooming areas available).

If your dog eliminates in the ring, you will be provided with the necessities to clean it up.

The Show Committee has the right to limit grooming equipment & stack crates if it becomes necessary.

It is recommended that proof of current rabies vaccination be in the possession of exhibitors or handlers for all dogs at these shows.

EXHIBITORS MUST PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.

NO WASHING DOGS OR DOG BOWLS IN RESTROOMS. ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ALLOWED IN RESTROOMS.

THERE IS NO ROPING OFF OF AREAS, ROPES WILL BE REMOVED. NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.

Public exercise pens will be available.

NO EXERCISE PENS OR COCKER PENS INSIDE PAVILION 1.

It is recommended that dogs in crates not be left unattended.

The public address system will be used at the discretion of the show-giving clubs. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside for judging.

Exhibitors should be aware of recently reported attempts by animal rights groups to open crates and release dogs at dog shows. Dogs should not be left unattended at any time.

Every attempt will be made to keep the show site and all exhibitors' possessions secure; however, the show-giving club, their officials, members or agents are not responsible for any loss or damage to equipment or animals left in the auditorium at any time.

Loading & unloading will be restricted.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions around their grooming/crating areas.

Crating and grooming allowed in designated areas only. NO ELECTRICAL ACCESS IN THE FREE GROOMING. IF YOU DO PLUG IN, YOU WILL BE CHARGED THE \$90.00 FEE THAT THE CLUB HAS TO PAY. IF YOU NEED ELECTRICITY FOR GROOMING, PLEASE GET RESERVED GROOMING.

This is a NON-SMOKING FACILITY according to federal & state regulations. A FINE can be imposed if in violation. **THIS WILL BE MONITORED.**

An AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

CANADIAN/FOREIGN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entries received prior to the published opening date and time of entries or received prior to the publishing of this premium list will be returned without processing.

A service/processing fee of \$7.00 will be charged to each duplicate entry.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks nor will they be accepted toward entry fees.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$4.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.50 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

Each Entry processed through Jack Onofrio Dog Shows Telephone Entry Service or Onofrio Online Entry will have a service fee included in the amount charged to the payment card provided. Each user of either service acknowledges they are authorized to charge fees to the card provided for payment and further acknowledges the transaction is made over the phone or internet. 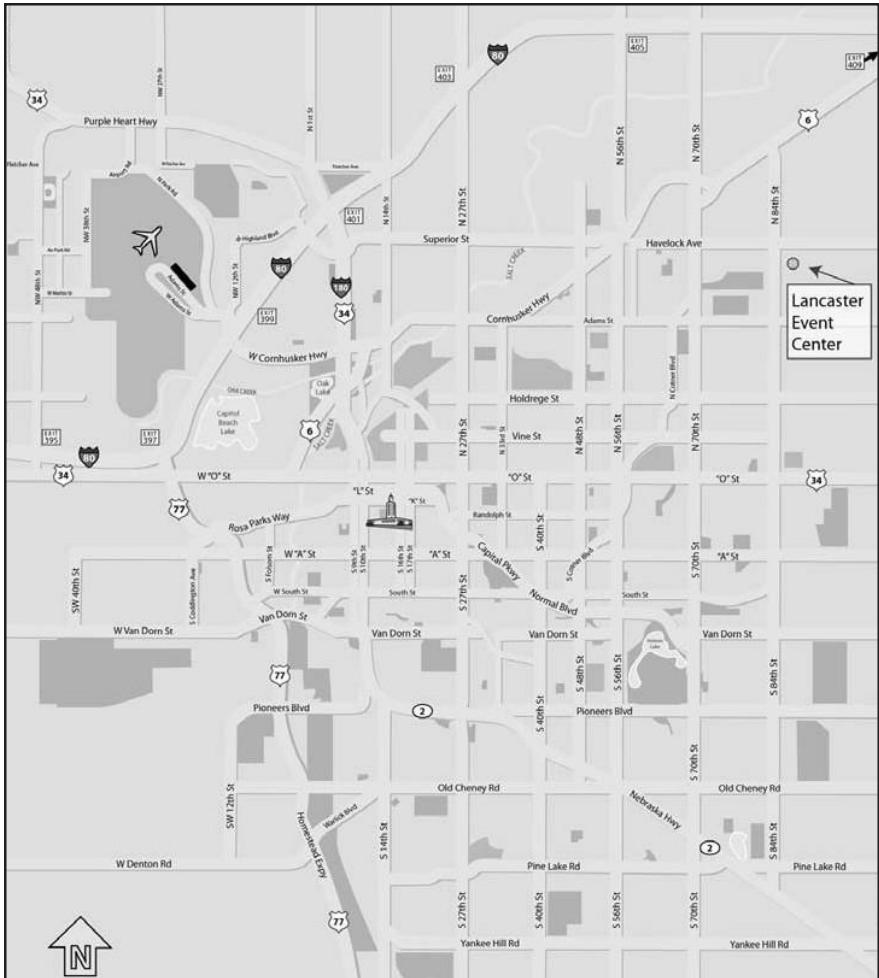
ROUTES TO THE SHOW

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG CLASS (7 Yrs & Under 9 Yrs) - A Class for Dogs seven (7) years & under nine (9) years of age.

VETERAN DOG CLASS (9 Yrs & Over) - A Class for Dogs nine (9) years & over.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS (7 Yrs & Under 9 Yrs) - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years & under nine (9) years of age.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS (9 Yrs & Over) - A Class for Bitches nine (9) years & over.

NEUTERED DOGS & SPAYED BITCHES MAY COMPETE IN VETERAN CLASSES AT THESE SPECIALTIES

FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs that have placed first, second, third or fourth in an AKC licensed or member field trial.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches that have placed first, second, third or fourth in an AKC licensed or member field trial.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and both dogs must be entered in another class

Pee Wee Competition

Friday, October 2, 2026
JUDGE: Miss Hadley George

ENTRY FEE: FREE

Entries will be taken the morning of the show at the Club table.

Judging will be held during a break - See Judging Schedule

Do not send entries to Onofrio - enter day of at GWP ring.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation ribbon to commemorate the experience!

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show the bite.

SWEEPSTAKES
REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION**

Sweepstakes is open to German Wirehaired Pointers that are 6 months & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." Anyone in good standing with the AKC may handle an entry.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

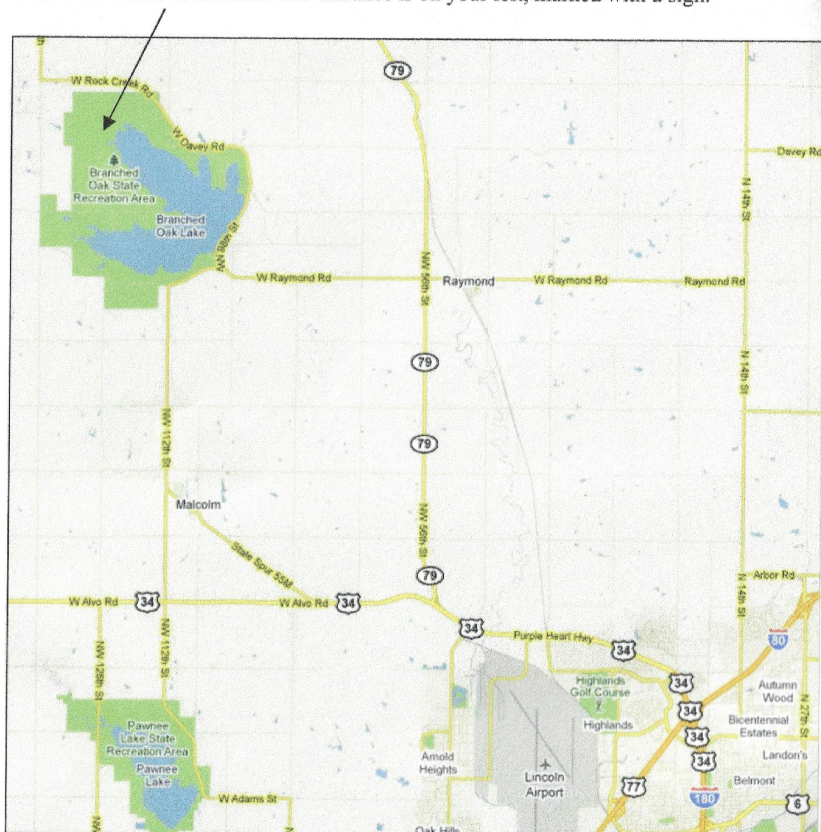

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.

- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
